Excepts from Administrative Bylaws relative to Officers and Elections

Term of Office

- The term of office for the elected officers of council shall be one year and shall begin at the close of the annual meeting immediately following the election process.
- While President-Elect this individual shall for all purposes remain a member of the Council for one-year term as President-elect, one-year term as President and one-year term as past-President.

Officers of the Council

- The officers of the Association will be the president, past president, president-elect and executive director. Officers need not be directors prior to election.
- The duties of the President and President-Elect are such as their titles by general usage indicate or as may be required by law, or as specified or assigned to them from time to time by the Council.
- The President will chair all meetings of the Council and is an ex-officio member of Council committees. If the President is absent, unable or unwilling to act, the President-Elect assumes the duties of the President.
- The President-Elect assists the President in all respect, reviews the bylaws and "Council Handbook" yearly and recommends revisions.

Eligibility:

- Practising members in good standing may be elected as members of the council with the following exceptions:
 - Employees of the association shall not hold elected office;
 - Elected officers shall not hold the same office for more than two consecutive terms without an election.

Election of Officers:

- The President, President-Elect and Past President serve a one-year term.
- The President automatically succeeds to the position of Past-President and the President Elect automatically succeeds to the position of President at the end of a one-year term. Nothing within these bylaws prevents a President and President Elect from remaining in their positions for one additional one-year term with their written agreement and a two-thirds majority vote of the Council.
- Subject to a two-thirds majority vote of Council a President may seek a third term of office through an election.

Nominations:

- Members are eligible to submit nominations to the Past President.
- Two active members must sign a nomination form.
- A nomination must be accompanied by the signed consent of the nominee.
- Nominations will be accepted from the floor of the annual general meeting.
